



## Care instructions → Textile Shower Curtains

Please follow the special care instructions in the catalogues and on the sewn-in care labels for all spirella articles.



Wash monthly (40°C) and iron.

- hose down with warm water after every shower
- leave to dry stretched out during the day

### Care of your shower curtain in the case of mould stains:

Place the stained part of the curtain into chlorine leach and move it around continuously.

Solution 1/2 L 7% chlorine leach (Cl) = Javelle on 10 L warm water.

CAUTION: Do not use with cotton curtains  
Immediately(!) rinse well in a lot of cold water.  
Wash in the washing machine (40°) with detergent.  
Hang up whilst damp.

### In order to avoid further fungal decay...

ensure good air circulation. Check whether your bar is not mounted too high: it should be at least 20 cm from the ceiling. Please open the curtain well out to dry after every shower. A breeding ground for fungi can develop in a warm, moist environment. Open window or turn on ventilator/air-conditioning.
